The Lyndoch Seeds of Hope Reflection sofa.

After consultation with representatives from each community sites have been chosen in local parks near creeks in Angaston, Lyndoch and Mt Pleasant. The positions will enable quiet reflection and connection to nature while being easily accessible. Additionally, nature-based themes have emerged from the design workshops held in each region, featuring segments of trees, birds, and fauna common to each area. Sunflowers on the rear of the sofas will link them to Barossa's Seeds of Hope Suicide Prevention Network.

The role of the Reflection Sofas as a symbol in the community is to continue Seeds of Hope Suicide Prevention Network's goal of reducing stigma which is a barrier to people who are struggling to reach out for help. The keys to suicide prevention are connection, education and stigma reduction as well as connecting people to services. A QR code is planned that will link people to help services.

It is hoped the Sofas will be a prompt to ongoing discussions about suicide prevention and a place of solace for those impacted by suicide. The Sofas will be an invitation to reflect and connect

and it's hoped they will also become a focal point for International Survivors of Suicide Loss Day, 23rd of November when they are due to be completed.

Kristin Wohlers, a local mosaic artist is leading the build and guiding the design and construction of the mosaic elements. Kristin is present to conduct the initial workshops showing everyone the safe use of the tools, how to construct the mosaic element and the design process.

Once the sofas have been built and installed in each area, the mosaics will be transferred to each sofa and grouting will complete the process.

Susan Raven, Maria Ross, Mary Ann Murphy and Jacqui Possingham form the working group who on behalf of Seeds of Hope Suicide Prevention Network are coordinating the project.

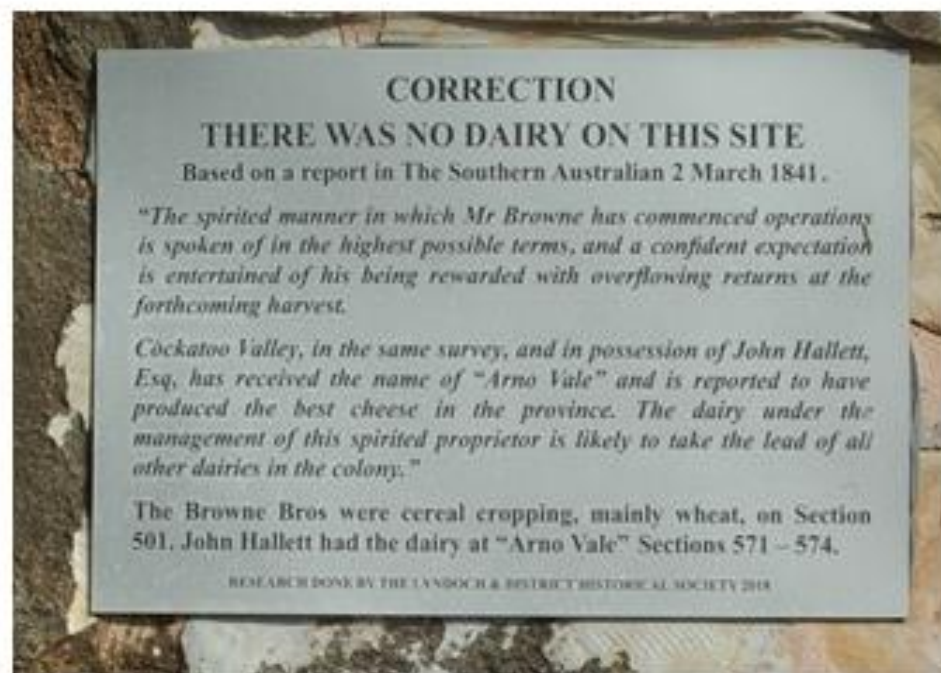
The topic will be Pioneer Park history and the contribution provided by Otto Tepper. It marks the centenary celebration of the District Council of Barossa accepting the trust deed for the Pioneer Park in June 1923 and also the 75th Anniversary of the erection of the cairn and plaque recording the site's history.



Lyndoch Pioneer Trees

These trees mark the site of the dairy and stockyards of Dr John Browne, the first settler in the district about 1839. The land on which they stand was purchased by J.G.O. Tepper F.R.S. and placed by him in trust of the District Council of Barossa for their effective protection.

A plaque has been added to correct the error stating that the site was a dairy.
