The Historical Society's first meeting for the year will be held on Sunday 4th February at 2.00 p.m. in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library. The topic for the occasion is the history of the Lyndoch Mill which unfortunately was destroyed by fire 65 years ago in 1959.

It took four afternoons to erect it and we take this opportunity of thanking all who ungrudgingly gave their labour to beautify their church – also those who subscribed to the cost – but of course, most of all those who did both. Messrs M. and H. Burge deserve the lion's share.

The painting is still to be done and we hope that when the "bee" is called a good number of "artists" will respond. Nor must we forget the ladies who so kindly gave us afternoon tea.

Six "working bees" were held in connection with the building and painting of this fence. Unfortunately, after all the effort it is no longer there.
