

School Holiday Program

LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY



The next meeting of the Lyndoch Historical Society will take place in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library on Sunday 6th August commencing at 2.00 p.m.

The topic will be Pioneer Park history and the contribution provided by Otto Tepper. It marks the centenary celebration of the District Council of Barossa accepting the trust deed for the Pioneer Park in June 1923.

He also played a key role in conservation initiatives and this led to the preservation of two gum trees standing on the site of the first settler in Lyndoch Valley, Dr John Browne.

Soon after his return to Lyndoch for the Institute opening, Otto Tepper notified Council that he had purchased the land on which the two gum trees were growing that marked the site of farm buildings of the first settler in Lyndoch and asked Council to hold the trees in trust.



Following Tepper's death on 16.2.1923, Council received a copy of his will indicating that the allotment containing the Pioneer Trees had been given in trust to them.



In July 1936 being South Australia's Centenary Year, Mrs William Gilbert of Wongalere, made an offer to Council to provide a cyclone fence with double gates for the Pioneer Tree allotment. This was accepted and went ahead.

75 years ago in July 1948 Council workmen erected a cairn of rough stone, from Kies' quarry, in the fenced Pioneer Tree allotment. A bronze plaque, donated by Oscar Seppelt, detailing the history of the site was attached to the cairn.

A plaque has been added to correct the error stating that the site was a dairy.

1837 BarossA



Our winery 1837 Barossa commemorates the date on which Colonel William Light, founder of Adelaide and first Surveyor-General of South Australia named the Barossa in December 1837.

The Barossa Colonel Light Monument, a life-size bronze statue of Colonel Light on horseback honours the birthplace of the Barossa on the estate. Our label is symbolizing Colonel Light pointing towards the Barossa Range when naming them in 1837. In honour of Light's monumental achievements, each of our wines is telling a story from his rich and colourful life.

SOUTHERN BAROSSA MEN'S SHED

The Men's Shed is a concept which is growing in popularity and increasing in number in Australia and around the globe. It provides an outlet for men, much in the same way that the backyard shed has in Australian culture over many years.

The Southern Barossa Men's Shed (SBMS) welcomes men from all walks of life to attend our Shed, you can participate in a range of activities in the workshop if that is your desire or you can simply turn up for 'a cuppa' and socialise with others in a non pressured setting. The Men's Shed does not follow a strict format but it does encourage fellowship. Projects are also undertaken which benefit the community.

Making or repairing furniture or homewares or toys, mending and fixing motors, renovating bicycles, arts and crafts, all examples (but certainly not the limit) of the activities that can be undertaken at the Shed depending on the knowledge and skillset of the members. There is an emphasis on 'having a go' with projects but there is no pressure, it is most important for men to enjoy the activities, have a sense of

belonging and feel happy in the Shed environment.

Men with an interest in the activities of the SBMS are welcome to attend on Tuesdays and Wednesdays between 9am-1pm. at the rear of Wirraminna Little Shop of Treasures on Queen Street, Williamstown.

We have been successful in obtaining a grant of \$3,650 from the Federal Government via Social Services. This has enabled us to purchase a new bandsaw and fittings. Grants like this add to the diversity of activities our men can enjoy.

Also thanks to The Barossa Council for a grant of \$3,000 to enable a cement pad in front of the shed making wintry access for those with disabilities. Thanks to all who helped make this possible.

Men from the shed continue to enjoy a special lunch on the last Wednesday of each month.


