

LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The next meeting of the Lyndoch Historical Society will be held on Sunday 28th April commencing at 2.00 p.m. in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library The topic for the occasion is to mark the 110th Anniversary of the commencement of World War I and discover the happenings that were taking place in Lyndoch in 1914.

A fire occurred on 5th December 1914 at 2.30 a.m. when the Travellers' Rest Hotel was destroyed. A traveller sleeping in a room adjoining the bar was woken by the sound of burning timber and the smell of smoke. He alerted members of the Linke family but by the time the nine occupants escaped in night attire, the place was well ablaze.

Many spectators attempted to enter the premises from the rear but the heat was intense and little could be done in that direction. The roof was scaled by others and with the aid of buckets of water prevented the fire spreading to four disconnected rooms. The hotel was badly damaged and also the contents save for a few personal effects and a portion of furniture, which was secured at great risk.

The building was insured for £1000 and was owned by Mr Robinson of Balaklava. The cause of the fire was unknown but it was surmised that it was probably caused by a cigar or cigarette smouldering in the sawdust and being fanned into flame.






