Mt Torrens CFS

As our fire season and fire risk reduces, we are still bound by fire bans in the Mount Lofty Ranges to at least the end of April. Please check with CFS web site to confirm finish date before conducting any burn offs. Be aware of council restrictions of burning rubbish within township.

It's time to commence maintenance for winter. Clean out your gutters to prevent water overflow into house. Clean out any drains around your property in case of heavy downpours.

Remember not to park your car under trees during storms or high winds.

When did you last have your flue cleaned? Chimney fires are common over the winter months.

Clothes dryers need to have the filters cleaned out regularly. If drying clothes in front of heaters, please keep items a minimum of 1 metre away.

Driving conditions will deteriorate with poor visibility of fog, and roads can become wet and slippery. Allow extra time to get to your destination and drive to the conditions. Don't become a statistic!!! We now have our second mosaic tub completed, thanks to local mosaic artist Robby Towill. This is in memory of the 1939 Black Friday fires, when many local houses were destroyed along with part of Amscol factory (Now Coopers). The methods of fighting fires, with hessian sacks and tree branches, is certainly very different to today's methods.

The fire fighters were from Amscol factory, and local communities including farmers and anyone prepared to get in and help. The next tub will be the Ash Wednesday 2 . *Sheryl Collins (Captain)*

Mt Torrens Community Garden

Have you seen our wonderful sign for the Community Garden? Sheryl Collins designed and made the sign for us. We are fortunate to have such a talented artist involved in our garden. Sheryl hid a snail amongst the wonderful produce she depicted on the sign. Come down and see if you can find it.

It's changeover season in the garden, from summer to winter crops. This means we will be removing most of the summer crops very soon so that we can replenish the nutrition in the soil prior to planting. We will be

using a combination of aged horse manure, compost and Rooster Booster. We have already started some seedlings in pots, so that they will be well advanced by the time we plant them out. We have lots of lettuce, bok choy, silverbeet, spinach and broccoli. We will also plant sugar snap peas and snow peas directly.

Whilst we had a grant to start the Community Garden, we do not have any ongoing funding. With this in mind, if you have any excess seedlings, compost, fertilisers etc we would very much appreciate any garden related (non money) donations. We would also love some new members.

The group meets at the community garden every 1st Saturday and 3rd Sunday of the Month, from 9am to 11am. We work on the

vegetable garden and the native garden, that is when we are not chatting and sharing information.

We look forward to seeing you in the garden, to drop off some donations or to join in. *Sue Scott*

Adelaide Hills Council

Council has commissioned a report on strategic priorities for potential Main Street/Town Centre upgrades throughout the council area.

1) The council has requested the CEO to investigate options for providing preference to traditional custodians and other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander stakeholders to purchase, lease or use vacant council owned or Crown land managed by Council. Report is due by 30 June 2023

2) Council has authorised the CEO to prepare a report on a proposal to remove citizenship, award ceremonies and related events to a date other than 26 January from 2024 onwards .

3) Council meetings. Meeting times have changed as follows since the new council was elected. 1st Monday workshop at Nairne Road Woodside; Meetings 2nd and 4th Tuesdays at Stirling and Workshop/Professional development 3rd Tuesday at Stirling. All meetings commence at 6.30pm 4) Negotiations regarding the extension of the Amy Gillett bikeway to Birdwood continue at the highest level, including a deputation by the Mayor to the Minister for Infrastructure and Transport. A decision is expected, including funding arrangements, by early May.

5) The consultation period for the Draft Long-Term Financial Plan closes on 31 March. The Plan is available on the web site.
