Please be advised that Council has set the dates for the 2023 Free Green Waste Disposal Days

For Transfer Station operating times and locations please visit www.mid-murray.sa.gov.au

April	8 & 9 April
July	15 & 16 July
October 2023	30 September & 1 October

What will be accepted: clean residential green waste, including:

- Grass clippings
- Prunings
- Leaves
- Small branches, up 100mm in diameter

What will not be accepted:

- Commercial loads of materials
- Waste or hard rubbish
- Soil
- Proclaimed weeds, these include: rose, poplar, blackberry, gorse, olive, bridal creeper, kikuyu, couch and bamboo

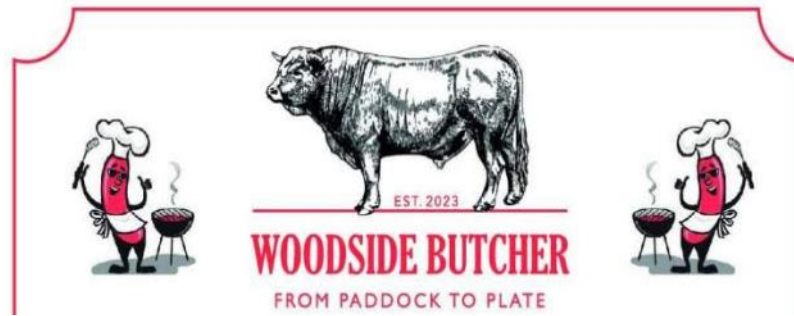

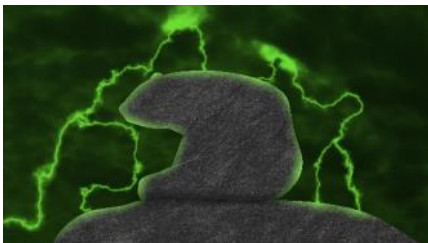
