'Face and Body Image' in Williamstown

We frequently walk past premises in our busy lives without thinking too much about what could be on offer behind that shop frontage! Or maybe we think, "I'll try that some day!" The other day, I discovered a delightful gem in 'Face and Body Image', located one leapfrog over the hairdresser's from the Post Office! 'Face and Body Image' is owned by Cindy who has been a Williamstown local for 15 years. She moved here from Para Hills with her husband Sean and two daughters, Mikaela and Brianna. But Cindy's story really begins back in 1988 when at the age of 17 she undertook a 12-month Diploma Course in Beauty Therapy and Massage at the Heather Langton Academy of Beauty in Adelaide. In the following year, at the ripe-old age of 18, Cindy started her business, utilizing 2 rooms in the gym section of the Elizabeth Aquadome. After 12 months the facility was proving too small for the growing business, and so, a move was made to a shop at Brahma Lodge. However, this also was quickly outgrown, and a bigger premise was located at Salisbury East. While at the Salisbury East shop Mikaela was born. Cindy's mother stepped in to care for the new arrival while Cindy kept on working but, feeling she was not seeing enough of her daughter, Cindy, with husband Sean, had a separate building erected on the family's house block at Para Hills to cater for the flourishing business. This meant that Cindy, still with the help of her mother, could spend more time with her daughter. When Brianna was born this arrangement catered for her too. When the move was made to Williamstown, however, there were no shops available for lease, so Cindy and Sean rented and built out half of the old Fire Station at Ridgehaven, including converting the carport to transform their section into a proper salon with 3 large treatment rooms.

At Ridgehaven the young girls were catered for with more space and apparently provided much free entertainment for the clients. Once in Williamstown the girls were extremely lucky to have a wonderful mother who, for three years transported them daily back down to their old school in Para Hills. After this they attended St Jakobi's and then Faith Lutheran College. Down the track, and Mikaela now lives in Adelaide and works as a Disability Support Worker for Colourful Abilities while Brianna, who has been gifted with an amazing voice, is studying music while working part-time at the Cockatoo Valley Community Store.

Cindy continues to work alone, as always, from the Ridgehaven Salon as well as the Williamstown one which she opened 7 years ago. She is, however, a Registered Trainer in Beauty so there have been trainees working with her along the way. She works long hours but has never thought of doing anything else. Her salon in Williamstown consists of two treatment rooms and the small but eye-catchingly decorated waiting room! Cindy is such a friendly, welcoming, laughter filled lady that you feel at ease the moment you walk into her salon. She is a good listener so clients would feel comfortable explaining what's bothering them and being advised on which natural, healthy skin care regime to follow. For 24 years, Cindy has used Skeyndor Skin Care Products from Spain which "combine the goodness of nature with the wonder of science", time assuring her that they are the best. Cindy is also a distributor for "Young Living" essential oils, hair care and home cleaning products. Her brochure lists all the services she offers - "relaxation and beauty treatments including (different types of) massage therapy, stone therapy, facials, manicures, pedicures, waxing and an array of signature services." Reading through I found myself going — "Ooh, that sounds good!" over many offerings! Next step — make an appointment!

Cindy is in her Williamstown Salon every Monday and Tuesday from 9am-5pm and alternating Fridays from 9am-5pm. After hours appointments can be made for Tuesdays and Saturdays. The best way to contact Cindy is by text on 0411155325 as, being a total professional, she does not take phone calls while working with clients. She will answer your text at the earliest free moment. Cindy loves what she does, loves the products she uses and loves her clients, many of whom she has built up great relationships with over the years! I walked out of her salon feeling great – and I'd only been talking to, and laughing with, that very caring lady! Imagine how I would have felt if I'd actually had a treatment......!!! L.L.

New guidelines for signage

For release 6 July 2023

A new framework for how community and commercial signs on Council land are managed has been released for community consultation.

The Barossa Council hopes the new approach will ensure signage erected on Council land doesn't detract from the character and amenity of the region.

"We understand people want to place signs on Council land for a whole variety of reasons. But equally, we want to ensure the Barossa retains its character, and that signs don't become intrusive or clutter our local towns and roadsides," said Mayor Bim Lange.

"In actual fact, we haven't introduced significant changes, we've simply brought various information together in one policy to provide certainty and consistency.

"By being more explicit about our expectations, we can balance the needs of community as well as keeping our townships attractive and reflective of a premier tourism destination."

Mayor Lange said the draft Signage Policy provides clarity around what signage is appropriate, where it should be located and what approvals are needed, including commercial advertising and community promotional signage.

The Policy will sit alongside Location Guidelines that identify dedicated areas in townships where temporary community messaging and community event signage can be erected.

The Location Guidelines also place conditions around the size, appearance, maintenance and duration of temporary signage on Council land.




